Mary is a member of the editorial board of *The Chorister*, and the endowment committee of the Hymn Society in the United States and Canada.







These have appeared in such hymnals as *The New Century Hymnal*, *The Presbyterian Hymnal*, and *Ecumenical Praise*. For the first time, Diemer's hymns are now brought together in a single volume.
